Theodor Damian Dr. Damian serves as professor of philosophy, ethics and sociology in both the undergraduate and graduate programs at Metropolitan College of New York. In addition to teaching at MCNY since 1992, Dr. Damian has taught courses at St. Vladimir's Theological Seminary, the College of New Rochelle, and at Spiru Haret University, School of Journalism, Bucharest, Romania. He has served as a priest in Romania, as Dean of Dorohoi District and as a magazine editor. Dr. Damian has published over twenty books as well as hundreds of articles in poetry, theology and literary criticism, in both Romanian and English, in the United States and Europe. His books include Apofaze (poetry, Tracus Arte, Bucharest: 2012), The Isar Sign (poetry, PublishAmerica, Baltimore, MD: 2010), Philosophy and Literature: A Hermeneutic of the Metaphysical Challenge (Romania of Tomorrow Press, Bucharest: 2008), and The Icons. Theological and Spiritual Dimensions According to St. Theodore of Studion (The Edwin Mellen Press, Lewiston, NY: 2002). He has also been the recipient of prestigious awards for his work in academics, poetry and theology.
