PhD Maria-Cristina Gelep earned her bachelor's degree from the Faculty of Letters, University of Craiova, Romania, in 2012, with a thesis on the poetry, prose and dramatic works of Lucian Blaga. She completed her master's degree in Language and Literature at the same institution in 2014, within the program *Romanian Literature in the European Context*, with a dissertation on the prose of Max Blecher.

She subsequently obtained her PhD in Comparative Literature from the University of Craiova in 2018, defending a doctoral thesis entitled *The Academic World in Romania and Anglo-American Prose*. Between 2023 and 2025, she was a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at Ovidius University of Constanța, where she conducted research on a project entitled *Representations of Postwar Literary Exile in Literature and Art (the United States and France)*.

From 2015 to 2017, she taught Romanian Language and Literature in the pre-university education system. Since 2021, she has been serving as a Scientific Research Assistant at the Museum of Books and Romanian Exile in Craiova.

Her scholarly activity includes the publication of more than twenty original articles in academic volumes and over thirty papers presented at national and international conferences. Her research interests include American, British, and French literature, history, cultural studies, and exile literature.
