He had worked since October 2003 as assistant (until 2009) and lecturer (2009-present) at the University of Craiova, Specializations History, International Relations and European Studies, and Romanians in the History of Europe.

He obtained his Ph.D. in History, in March 2007. He had worked in projects based on European Funds (European Social Fund)-POSDRU and POCU. He had studied the Management of EU Institutions and he was scientific coordinator in Entrepreneurship and mentor of a group of students.

He has a Master Degree in European Studies (2006) and a Master Degree in Applied Philosophy in Organizations and Business Environment (2019) at the University of Craiova.
