Marius-Sorin Miclea is a diplomat, university lecturer, and career military officer.

He attended the “Mihai Viteazul” Military High School, the “Aurel Vlaicu” Military Air Force School, the Faculty of Law, and the National Defence College within the “Carol I” National Defence University.

He studied in France, earning a PhD in International Relations and European Studies from the University of Lyon, graduating Magna Cum Laude, as well as a Master’s degree in Political Science from the University of Grenoble. He was also the recipient of a French government scholarship during the 2004–2005 academic year.

He also completed postgraduate courses at the Institute for Advanced Studies in National Defence (IHEDN) in Paris. Between 1985 and 2002, he held various positions as an aviation officer in combat units of the Romanian Air Force.

Academically, he is a lecturer at the University of Sherbrooke in Montreal, an associate lecturer at Babeş-Bolyai University in Cluj-Napoca, and a guest expert at the National Defence College within the “Carol I” National Defence University. He is also the author of three books on international relations and geopolitics, as well as numerous articles in specialized publications.

Since 2008, he has been active in diplomacy within the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, carrying out assignments in Romania’s Foreign Service in countries across Southeast Asia, the Indochina Peninsula, South Asia, the Middle East, Europe, and North America.

Since 2018, Marius-Sorin Miclea has held the diplomatic rank of career Consul General.
