In 2026, she earned her PhD in Philology with a dissertation titled *The Construction of Anaphoric Relations in Romanian Discourse: A French-Romanian Contrastive Approach*, under the supervision of Prof. Daniela Dincă, PhD, for which she received the distinction of *Magna cum laude*. She has participated in numerous national and international academic conferences and has published scientific articles in collective volumes and specialized journals.
